TASTING NOTE

A deep ruby red in color, this full-bodied wine opens with bright cherry and anise aromas. Raspberry, anise and cedar throughout the palate lead to a textured finish of well-balanced tannins.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2015 Washington State harvest proved to be spectacular with a record crop level and excellent quality. All factors needed for success came together perfectly: cool nights, lots of warm weather in the growing season, and rain limited mostly to the shoulder seasons. Harvest started the third week of August and wrapped in the second week of November. The crop across the state was heavy, yet bountiful with quality. Our vineyard team enjoyed weather that enabled them to pick at will, affording perfect flavor, acidity and sugar levels.
