A deep, inky purple, this Cabernet Sauvignon shows a wonderful smoky nose with accents of cherries and leather. Dark fruit on the palate leaves you with a silky finish of vanilla, spice and dark chocolate.

ABOUT THE VINTAGE

The 2015 Washington State harvest proved to be spectacular with a record crop level and excellent quality. All factors needed for success came together perfectly: cool nights, lots of warm weather in the growing season, and rain limited mostly to the shoulder seasons. Harvest started the third week of August and wrapped in the second week of November. The crop across the state was heavy, yet bountiful with quality. Our vineyard team enjoyed weather that enabled them to pick at will, affording perfect flavor, acidity and sugar levels.
